SUBJECT: **Solicitation No. SGM500-07-R-1014,**
American Embassy Conakry – Consular Canopy Project

The Regional Procurement & Support Office, Frankfurt intends to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) under full and open competition procedures for construction services in connection with the modification/extension of the existing canopy at the American Embassy compound in Conakry, Guinea. Work would include limited site work, demolition and construction which shall include architectural, civil structural, electrical, mechanical, plumbing, life and safety disciplines. All construction work shall be made in accordance local building standards and construction conventions. Construction costs are estimated to range between US\$250,000 and US\$500,000.

Potential contractors shall be in possession of all required permits and licenses to perform general construction work in Guinea. Contractor shall obtain all locally-required permits and construction-approvals. Communication, correspondence, and documentation must be in English. The contract shall be subject to U.S. laws and regulations.

We intend to issue subject solicitation (RFP) on or before February 23, 2007. A separate letter will be issued in the event that a Pre-Proposal Conference and Site Visit will take place. It is expected that the contract will be awarded in April 2007.

Solicitation packages will be issued to firms providing written notice of their interest to RPSO, to the attention of Victoria Villar-Demmer at above fax numbers or Email address not later than February 16, 2007. Please use above subject-solicitation number as reference.

Firms receiving the solicitation package shall return the entire package to this office even if they do not submit an offer. Firms who fail to return the entire package may not be considered for future solicitations.
